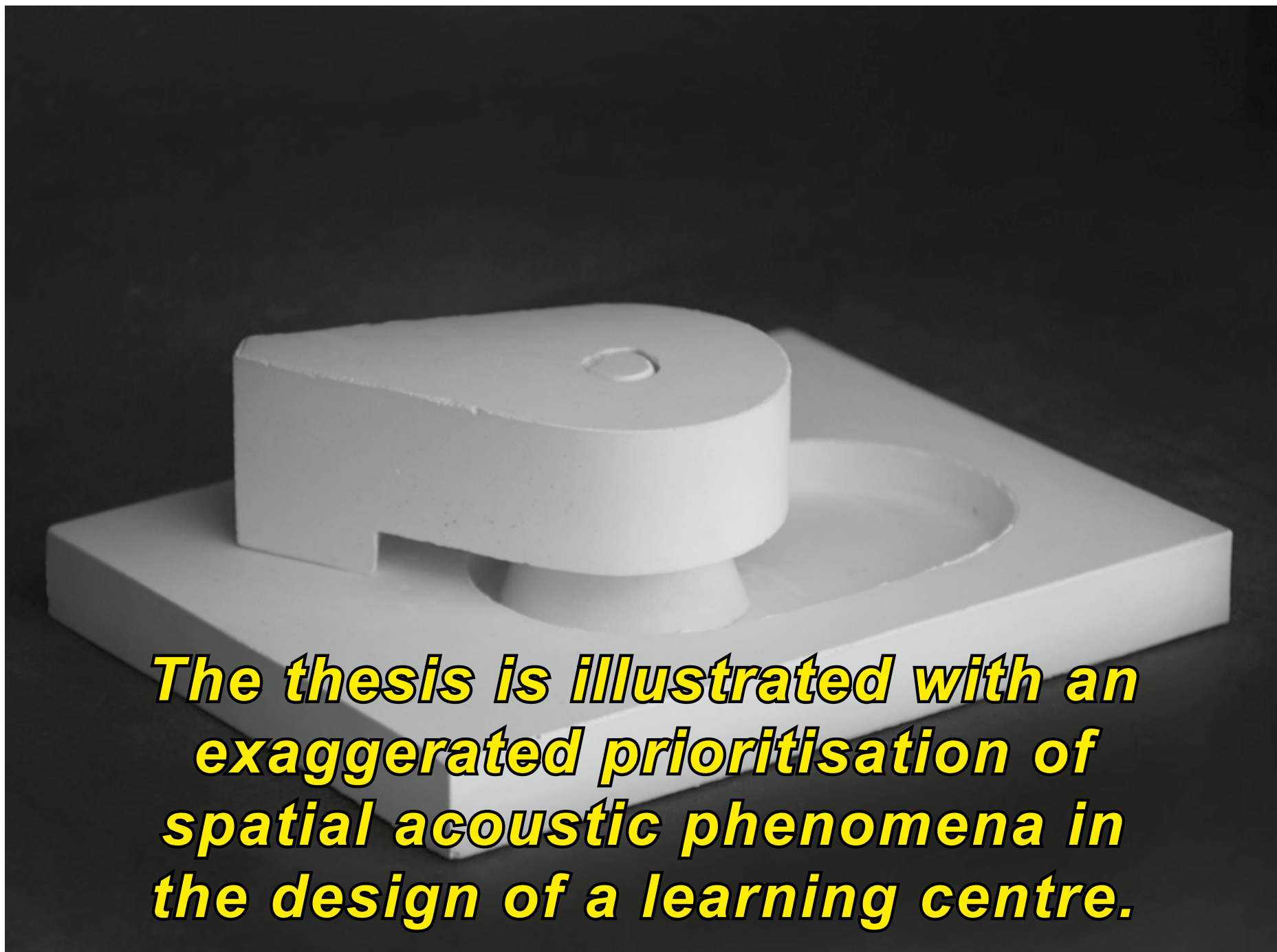

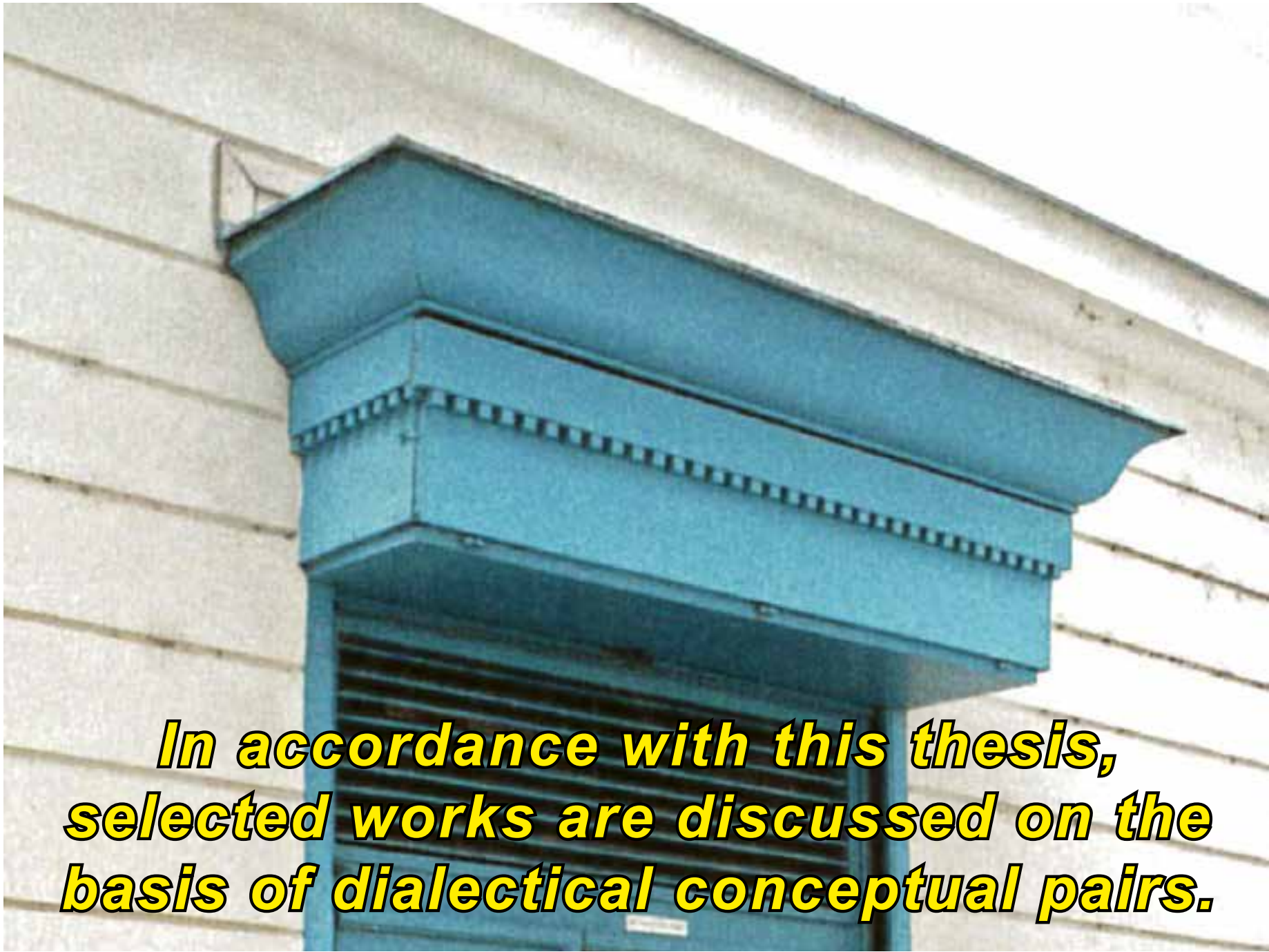

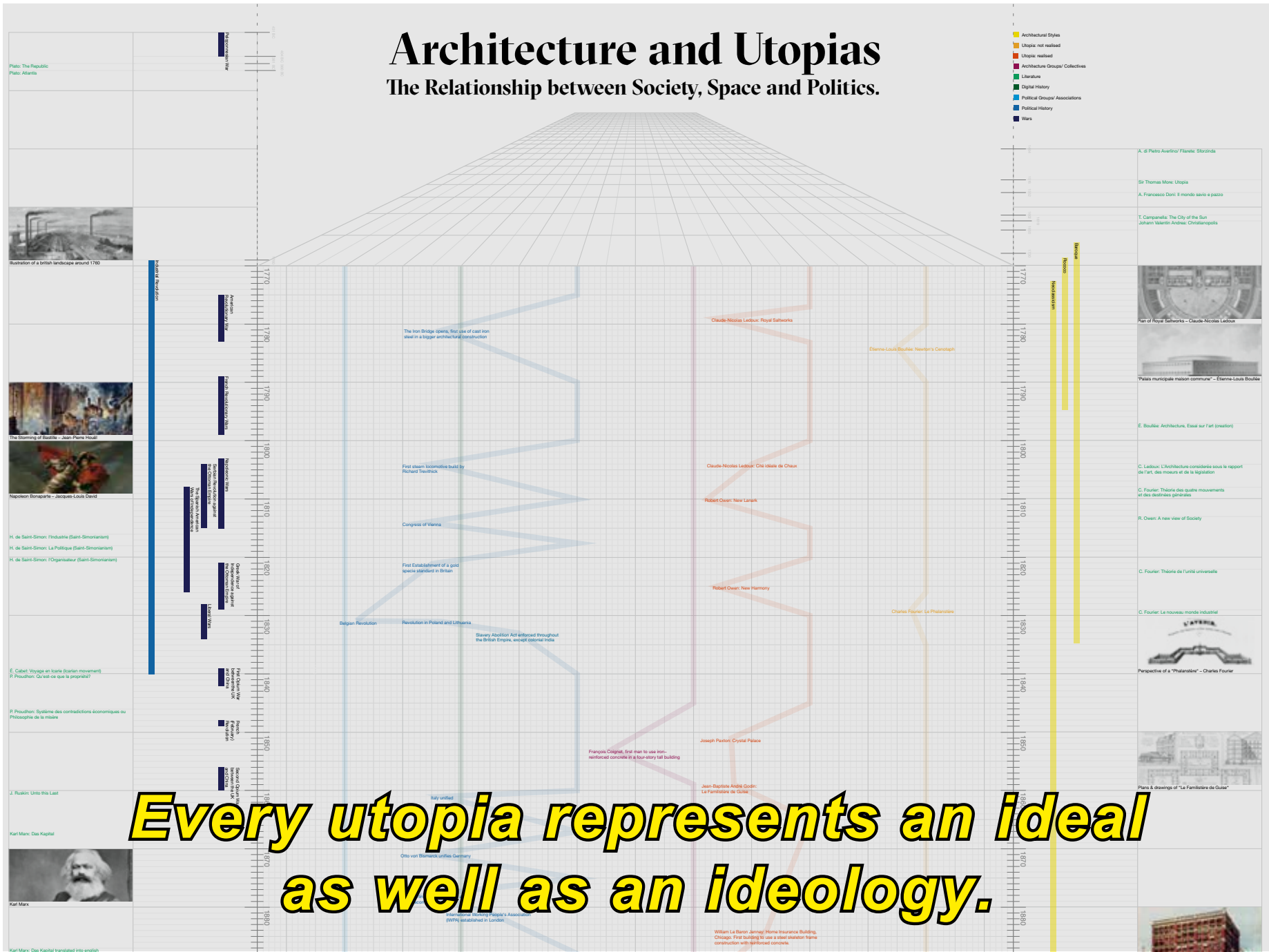
The provision of a 'docking-space' encourages casual exchange between users.

Every utopia represents an ideal as well as an ideology.



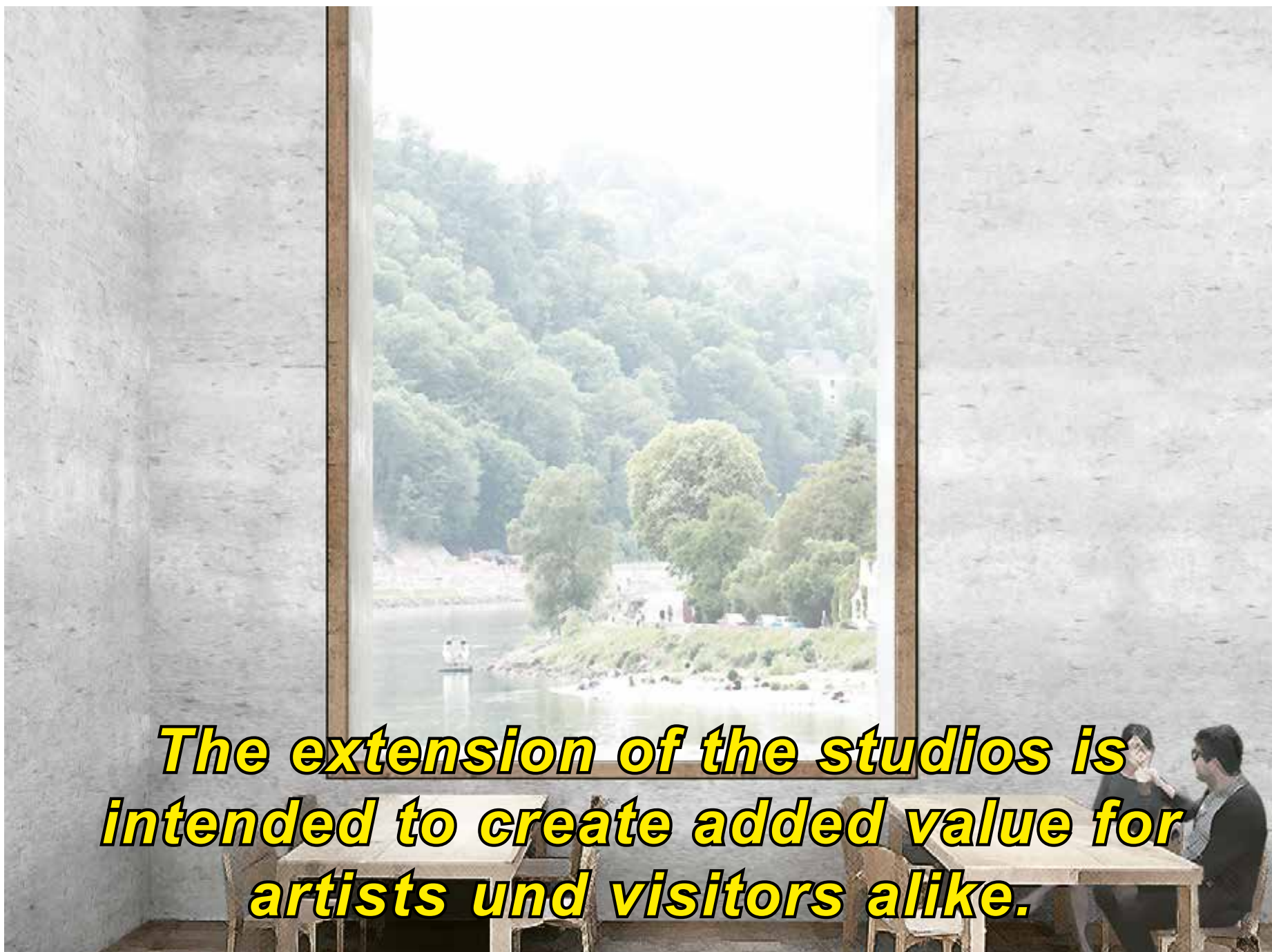
What is the multidimensional spatio-sociological impact of Silicon Valley on the San Francisco Bay Area?
